Up where we belong

The latest edition of the Raid de Himalaya 2018 will begin on October 10 and travel across Kargil, Zaskar, and Ladakh in Jammu and Kashmir. It will also include a ride from Lamayuru to Photoksar – which is a new inclusion in the rally's track. It is a newly-upgraded road that leads into Zaskar, which used to be a mule track. Crossing the Sirisir La at a height of 4,805 metres above sea level, the Raid de Himalaya has been cut short from six to four days now.
